Minutes:-

The Principal informed the committee that the Institution has been selected to get RUSA grant to the tune of Rs. 2 Crore. All the members rejoiced at it and the principal specially offered thanks to K.C. Mishra and S.N. Das for their effort in this matter.

It was unanimously decided in the committee to construct classrooms in the civil component amounting to Rs. 1.4 Crore. For the said construction it was decided to demolish the old and dilapidated rooms, from Room No-24 to 28. As regards Non-Civil grant, it was decided to provide 20 computers to the computer lab, procure latest equipment for science laboratories, furniture for classrooms and books for the library. It was also decided that a lab for Botany be constructed near the Zoology lab. The Principal also informed that the College has received UGC grants for the construction of one Indoor stadium and one Womens' Hostel. The sites for the said construction was selected in the meeting.

The members felt that the said grants will certainly transform the look of this old but neglected HEI of the locality.


The Committee then sat down to their regular business of chalking out action plan for the session 2015-16. The following were unanimously agreed upon –

1. Various depts. be encouraged to apply for UGC grants to conduct seminars and workshops.
2. Board of studies be made more effective and an exclusive meeting be organized to modify the syllabus as per UGC guidelines.
3. Meeting of the Academic Council be conducted to approve the modified syllabus.
4. More Social outreach programmes be conducted through NSS, YRC and NCC units of the College.

5. PTA and Alumni Association be reorganized to make them more effective. It was felt to be necessary in view of the forthcoming NAAC Peer Teams visit for NAAC reaccreditation.

After approving the plan of Action the meeting of the IQAC came to a close. The Coordinator expressed thanks to all the members for sparing their time for the meeting.
