Hence it is highly necessary to preserve the National Park along with its expansion with planting more saplings.

Practice:-

This institution undertook for massive plantation of saplings within the locality for the last 03 years in collaboration with Divisional Forest office, Karanjia (under Forest, Environment and Climate change Department, Govt. of Odisha. This institution plants about five thousand saplings every year.

Evidence of Success / Outcome:-

The outcome of the practice is that the student community who are future of the nation are directly involved in the Socio- academia and environmental thrust area to a remarkable increase of forestry within this locality. Now the college has already created a beautiful greenery in the village of Sarubali under Karanjia NAC by planting more than 5000 saplings in 2022 and this institution has also created a green environment at village Sukruli under Sukruli block by plating more than 5000 saplings in 2023.

Title of the Practice:- Education with Social responsibility by organsing a Mega Health Checkup -Cum-EYE Camp (Cataract Surgery)

Objective:-

Good health is a vital requirement for a healthy society. To maintain it, this institution regularly organises mega health checkup camps in collaboration with different health care agencies like Mahatma Gandhi Eye hospital, Rasgobindpur, Bhumika Eye hospital, Jaraka including Sub-divisional headquarters hospital, Karanjia. The objective of this programme is to eradicate blindness from the tribal people.

Context:-

This institution can't achieve our target without a healthy society. As this locality is a tribal dominated one and about 65% people are tribals and illiterate, they are unaware about their health. They are always dependent upon their traditional method of treatment of diseases. After organising Mega Health Checkup camps remarkable changes among the people of this locality have taken place.

Practice:-

This institution has been practicing this method for last 03 years for the benefit of tribal as well as non-tribal people of this locality since 2020-21. About 300 hundred cataract surgeries were done in the health camps in phased manner. Now, the people of this locality are expecting us about the next date of mega health checkup camps.

Evidence of Success / Outcome:-

The outcome of this practice is very encouragable and fruitful. About 300 Cataract Surgery with distribution of free glasses, free medicines among the needy patients have been done. The people of the village Ankura, Sarubali, Rasamtala and different wards of Karanjia NAC under Panchpir Sub- Division, Karanjia of Mayurbhanj district and some people of Saharpara under Keonjhar district have been benefitted by the health camps.

BEST PRACTICE -III

Title of the Practice:- Introduction of Santali language as a core and an elective subject.

Objective:-

Since tribal languages and cultures constitute an inherent part of Indian heritage in general and Odishan heritage in particular, the primary objective is to promote Santali language and literature and to preserve their cultural heritage. In view of it, the institution has introduced Santali Language as a new Core subject since 2021-22 and as an elective subject from the academic year 2020-21. Karanjia Autonomous College is the only institution in Odisha under MSCB University which has a department of Santali for the purpose of teaching at U.G. stage. The main objective of the department is to preserve, encourage & to publish literature in Ol Chiki scripts (Santali).

Context:-

According to UNESCO, many languages are on the verge of extinction from the world. Besides, STs constitute 22.85% of Odisha's population in general and 58.7% in Mayurbhani district in particular. Therefore preservation of tribal languages in Odisha is very relevant. Besides, Santali has the Ol Chiki script and is included under Schedule VII of our Constitution. Before the introduction of OI Chiki script, the Santalis used to write in various languages such as Odia, Bengali and Hindi. The real challenge is to publish them in Ol Chiki scripts and introduce Santali as a subject in U.G. stage for the larger interest of the tribal community.

Practice:-

The institution has already introduced Santali language as an elective subject since 2020-21 and as a Core subject since 2021-22. At present many tribal students are interested to take their admission in Santali subject. The institution recruited 02 Nos. Santali faculties to run the department.

Evidence of Success / Outcome:-

The department of Santali of this institution is presently engaged in teaching Santali language at U.G. stage and at present about 12 students have taken their admission. More students are expected to take admission in Santali language from the next years.

Problems encountered and resources required:-

The institution is facing a lot of difficulties to procure the qualified faculties through the recruitment process conducted by the institution. The institution is also facing several difficulties for evaluation of Answer scripts of the examinations by the external examiners. Apart from that, inadequate financial resources and lack of publication in OI Chiki scripts are creating a vacuum to fulfill our aims and objectives.
